

Neurozal®

Food supplement

Composition:

- Each Film coated tablet of **Neurozal**® contains:

Vitamin B1	100 mg
Vitamin B6	100 mg
Vitamin B12	200 mcg

Properties:

- **Neurozal** is a combination of three essential vitamins.
- Vitamins B1, B6, B12 are of special importance for the metabolism in the peripheral and central nervous system. Their effect on the regeneration of nerves has shown in various investigations using the vitamins individually and in combination.
- Vitamin B1 plays an important role in major metabolic processes.
- Vitamin B6 has an analgesic effect.
- Vitamin B12 ensures blood cell formation and prevents degenerative processes of the nervous system.

Indications:

Neurozal is used for:

- The supportive treatment of neuritis and neuralgia (neuropathies), e.g.: trigeminal neuralgia, intercostals neuralgia, lumbar syndrome, cervical syndrome, shoulder arm syndrome, radicular neuritis due to degenerative diseases of the vertebral column, facial palsy.

Dosage and administration:

- One tablet daily to treat moderate cases.
- **Neurozal** tablet is swallowed without chewing with a little liquid with or after meals.
- The duration of treatment is determined by the doctor.

Contraindications:

- **Neurozal** must not be used in patients hypersensitivities to any of the active ingredient or excipient of the product.
- **Neurozal** must not be used in children under 2 years of age.

Side effects:

- Mild diarrhea, nausea and gastric upset.
- Hypersensitivity to vitamin B (rash, urticaria, difficulty in breathing, chest tightness, swelling of body, face, lips or tongue and skin numbness).

Precautions:

- Inform your doctor about your current list of medications before taking **Neurozal** or if your condition persists or worsens.

Overdose:

- Prolonged over dose of vitamin B6 i.e. for longer than 2 months and more than 1 g per day may lead to neurotoxic effects.
- Very high doses of vitamin B1 (over 10g) have ganglion-blocking effect (suppressing the conduction of nerve impulses in the autonomic nervous system).
- Sensory neuropathy which is characterized by lack of coordination, numbness, decreasing touch sense, fever of shaking.

Drug interactions:

- Patients treated with L-dopa should not receive preparations containing high doses of pyridoxine because it reduced the effect of L-dopa.

Pregnancy and Lactation:

- **Neurozal** may be administered during pregnancy and lactation at the recommendation of the physician.
- In individual cases high doses of vitamin B6 i.e. > (600 mg daily may inhibit the production of breast milk).

Special precautions for storage:

- Keep out of the reach and sight of children.
- Do not use **Neurozal** after the expiry date which is stated on the container.
- It should be stored in a cool, dry place and at temperature not exceed 30°C.
- Keep in original container.

Nature and content of container:

- Box of 2 blisters.
- Each blister contains 10 film coated tablets.

Special precautions for disposal:

- Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste.
- Ask the pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.
- These measures will help to protect the environment.
